Materials

- White Glue or Glue Gun
- Transparent Paper
- Wood Skewers
- Ruler

- Markers
- Cardboard

THE GREAT PYRAMIDS



Step 1:

Instructions

Use the ruler to measure and mark a square shape on the cardboard (about 6 inches by 6 inches is a good size). Cut it out to create your base. Use the markers to decorate the base if you want!



Step 2:

Cut four triangles out of the transparent paper. Each triangle should have a base of about 6 inches (the same as your cardboard base) and a height of about 8 inches. Use the markers to decorate the triangles if you like!



Step 3:

Take one triangle and glue one edge to the base. Hold it for a moment until it sticks. Repeat this with the other three triangles, gluing them to the base and connecting their edges at the top. If you want extra support, you can use skewers to hold the triangles together. Just poke the skewers into the base and into the triangles.



Step 4:

Once the glue is dry and the pyramid is stable, you can add any finishing touches! Use markers to add designs to the base or the pyramid sides.
